INDEMNITY FORM

1. By signing the agreement on page 1, the entrant acknowledges and agrees they will have no claim whatsoever against the Western Sydney Historical Truck Club or any of the committee thereof or against any other person associated with the organisation of the "Haulin' The Hume Road Run 2019" (all of whom are hereafter "the organisers").
 - a). Whether such claims shall arise out of personal injury or property damage,
 - b). Whether caused or contributed by act or omission of the organisers *and*
 - c). Whether occurring prior to, or during, or after "Haulin' the Hume Road Run 2019".
2. The entrant also agrees that he/she will indemnify the organisers against any claim as aforesaid which might be made by the driver or passengers in the entrant's vehicle, against the organisers.
3. I acknowledge that I have read, understood and accepted the rules and condition of entry to "Haulin' the Hume Road Run 2019".

To assist with the smooth running of the event, the following RULES and CONDITIONS have been set.

 1. Only those commercial motor vehicles built on or before the 31st of December 1989 are eligible to enter.
 - b). All vehicles must be roadworthy, have current registration labels or permits affixed to the vehicle and drivers must be the holder of a current driver's license applicable to the vehicle being driven.
2. No motor vehicle will be permitted on the run using trade plates.
3. No substitution shall be made without the knowledge and written approval of the Entries Director and the payment of such fees as the committee may set.
4. Payment of entry fees will only be accepted by cheque or money order made payable to: 'Haulin' the Hume Inc'.
5. Any refund will be made solely at the discretion of the Committee whose decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
6. All entrants will observe the current road laws and speed limits on the route.
7. All entrants and passengers shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Entrants and passengers are subject to the directions and control in all things of the event organisers, their agents and officials.
8. Entrants conducting themselves in a dangerous manner or in a manner likely to bring "Haulin' the Hume Road Run 2019" and its organisers into disrepute shall be disqualified immediately.
9. The organisers reserve the right to reject or terminate any entry at any time for any reason.
10. The closing date for entries to "Haulin' the Hume Road Run 2019" is the 17th February 2019.
11. Entrants hereby authorise the organisers to photograph, film, or reproduce, in any medium the entrants motor vehicles used in the event and any other aspect of the event, and hereby acknowledge that the organisers shall have the free and unrestricted right to use entrants names and or such reproductions in the advertising and promotion of the event and of future events.
12. Please note that the current legislation does not allow passengers to be carried on the trays of trucks or utilities
13. The indemnity clause must be signed by the owner/ entrant of the motor vehicles and returned with your entry form.

NEW START LOCATION

HAULIN THE HUME IS NOW STARTING FROM CAMDEN, NSW.

- For your GPS, the entry point is located at Sheathers Lane, Camden • If you are travelling from interstate, the easiest way is to use the M5 Motorway and take the Narellan Road exit, heading toward Narellan. Turn onto the Camden By-Pass; follow along and across the long bridge and take the second set of lights, turning right onto Burragorang Rd (sign says to Oakdale/Oak Flats). Follow this to the next set of lights and turn right onto Cawdor Road. Sheathers Lane will be the first street on your left and the signs will show you the entrance on your right
- There are around 40 powered sites at the showgrounds along with plenty of extra room without power. Also plenty of places for a feed, some within walking distance.
- You will be able to enter the showground from 10:00am on Friday 29th and we will be there to pre- enter you Friday night or from 5am Saturday 30th. Departure will be around 7am.
- Coffee will be supplied by WSHTC and hopefully we can sort someone to be there cooking breakfast (as nothing is confirmed yet).

LUNCH

The lunch stop will be held at Goulburn Recreation Area in association with Yass Trotting Club which is located on the corner of Braidwood and Bungonia Roads with access for entrants via the gate on Bungonia Road. Gates open from 10:00am and we will have a short display there. Catering will be available on site via the Lions Club, Rotary Club as well as an inside eating area and bar. Departure will be from 2:30pm. There is plenty of parking for spectators and entrants and the area will be marshalled.

DINNER

Once again the dinner venue is located in the Yass Memorial Hall which is in on the right hand side of the main street, heading South, just past the Meehan Street lights. Parking is as last time (wherever you can) but there is a parking area behind where smaller vehicles can pull up. We are expecting to sell around 330 tickets. DOORS OPEN at 6:00PM.

MAPS, INCLUDING THE GOULBURN STOPOVER, WILL BE IN THE ENTRANT'S BAG, AVAILABLE UPON REGISTRATION.

The Sunday farewell will once again be held in Gasoline Alley in South Yass. Maps and details will be given on the Saturday night. Once again, Lions Club and some other local vendors will be onsite for breakfast.

ACCOMMODATION

Camden

Camping is available at Camden (Equestrian Centre) but it must be pre-arranged. Camden camping arrangements are to be paid via the entry form so if you haven't done so please contact us to arrange payment. **PLEASE** don't expect to simply turn up at Camden and expect to have free camping – it is not permitted.

Yass

There is plenty of accommodation in Yass but if you'd like to camp there is the Yass Showgrounds operated by the Yass Show Society. This must also be pre-booked at \$20 per truck and form as are available by visiting www.yassshow.org.au. Go to 'About', scroll down to 'Camping' and details with an online entry form are available. Yass Show Society has accommodated entrants for each Haulin' the Hume which we are grateful for but it is necessary to book online for future events. Payment is directly to the Show Society.

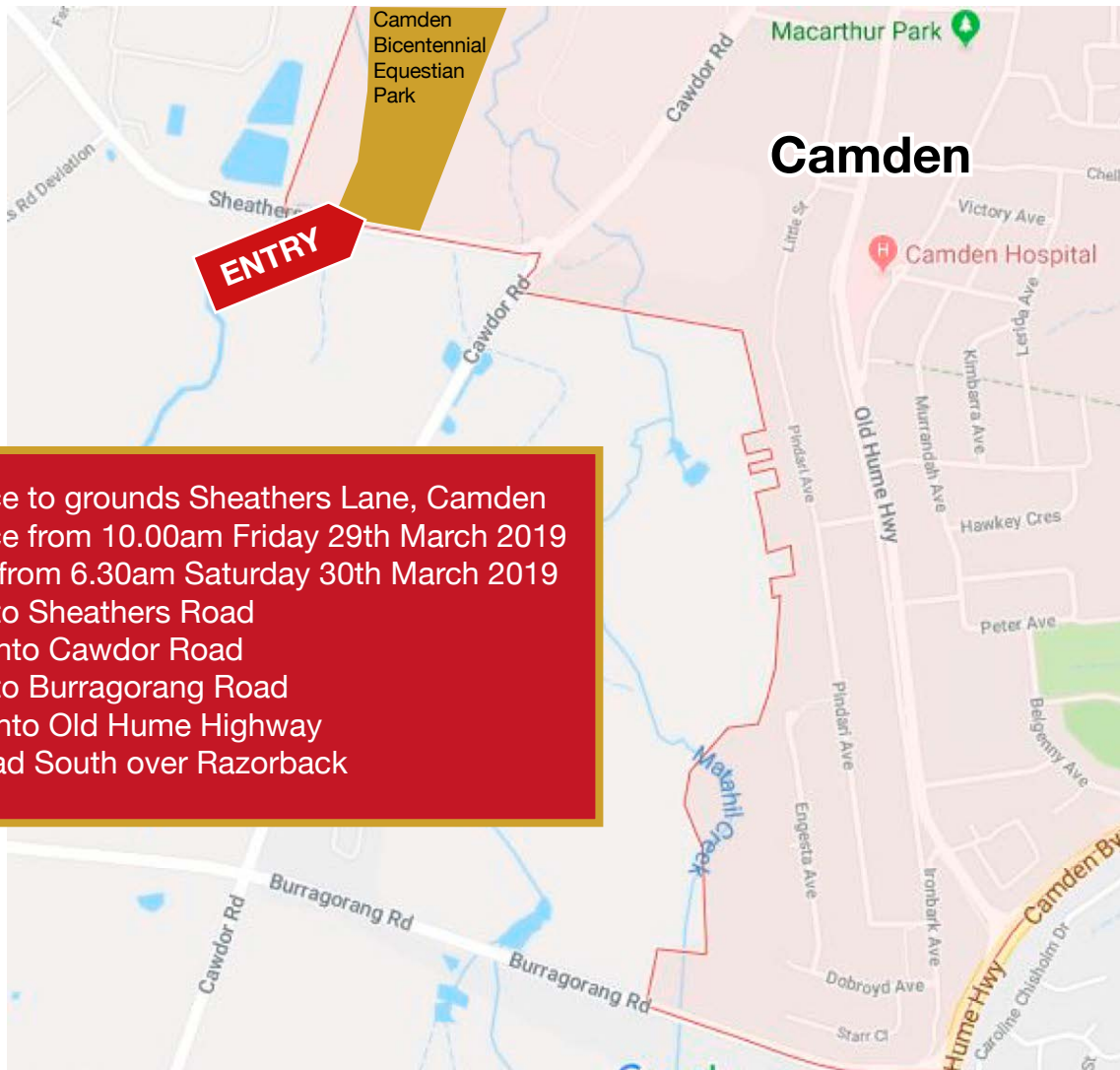

- Entrance to grounds Sheathers Lane, Camden
- Entrance from 10.00am Friday 29th March 2019
- Depart from 6.30am Saturday 30th March 2019
- Left onto Sheathers Road
- Right onto Cawdor Road
- Left onto Burragorang Road
- Right onto Old Hume Highway and head South over Razorback

- For Interstaters, take the Narellan Road exit off the M5 and it's 13.5km to the gate.
- Gates will be open from 10am on Friday for people wanting to camp.
- Camping entrants is \$25 per vehicle and there are about 40 powered sites (first in best dressed).
- Free tea and coffee for entrants on Saturday morning.
- Vehicles can register from midday Friday afternoon, or from 5:00am Saturday morning.
- Other accomodation is available at Camden, Smeaton Grange, Picton and Narellan.
